

Celebrate *your pronouns!*

What are pronouns?

We use pronouns such as she/her, he/him and they/them to identify or refer to someone.

Why identify them at an event?

Pronouns should not be assumed, so asking and correctly using someone's pronouns is one of the most basic ways to show your respect for their identity.

How should I do this?

Please feel free to include your pronouns on your name tag. When you meet someone, look for their pronoun sticker or introduce yourself using your pronouns, like:

“Hi, my name is Fen, my pronouns are they/them!”

Using pronouns creates a safer and more inclusive space for everyone, as it allows people to be open and authentically themselves!

Top tips!

- The use of pronoun stickers is optional and you may choose not to add pronouns to your name tag.
- Don't make it a big deal if you make a mistake. Correct yourself, apologise genuinely and move on.
- Respecting someone's provided pronouns is not optional so please use these respectfully or use their name.
